

MIDDLE SCHOOL FIELD TRIP TO GOLDWIND

On last last Friday, which is November 20th, the SMIC middle school students and teachers had their Fall (Actually it's Winter) field trip. They went to Goldwind technologies together and learned different kinds of knowledges about Goldwind, the company, and the technologies about it.

Since the company didn't allow us to take any photos of the tour, this passage will be purely words. But it's still interesting. The first and the biggest part of the tour is when we learned how Goldwind turbines produced energies through the turning of their big leaves. In addition to that, we also saw where they produced, checked, and kept their substation machines (Substation is the process of regulating the current to certain voltages to make them transportable).

Other than the wind-technologies of Goldwind, we also learned how the company clean the waste water from the Beijing sewer system. The waste water that went into Goldwind would go through a maximum of three filters: The first filter makes the water get rid of the solid trashes and some of the other liquids mixed inside them; the second filter clean the water to be able to use for washing and stuff, but still not drinking. And the third filter would finally make the water edible. Lastly, we learned about the planting system of Goldwind. Our guider leaded us through the glass house, filled with tomatoes and peppers, explaining to us about how Goldwind plant the plants with modified sunlight, temperature, humidity, and fertilizing.

To look at the trip conclusively, Goldwind is a really nice company, and we learned a lot of knowledges that we never knew before. This is an awesome field trip!


